PROGRAM DETAILS

- 25-30 hours/week of research for 9-weeks
- \$2,500 stipend
- Workshops and professional development sessions

- Upload CV
- Upload 250-word statement of interest (signed by PI)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Undergraduate researcher at UC Merced currently working in lab
- CCBM faculty or CCBM-affiliated faculty labs only
- Minimum GPA 3.0 cumulative at end of Fall 2017
- Must have approval from PI before submitting application
- Must be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or permanent resident to receive funding, per NSF guidelines
