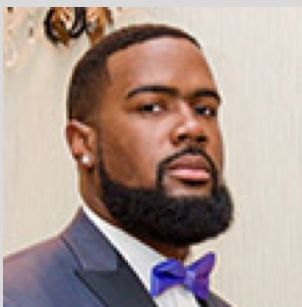

Stanford Biosciences is comprised of fourteen interdisciplinary home programs. Students pursuing their PhDs in the Biosciences at Stanford are **fully funded**, which includes tuition, medical and dental insurance, along with a competitive stipend. Currently there are close to 700 students enrolled in the Stanford Biosciences from various diverse backgrounds.

Stanford Biosciences also houses the **Stanford Summer Research Program**, a fully-funded 9-week residential research program for undergraduates interested in pursuing graduate studies.
